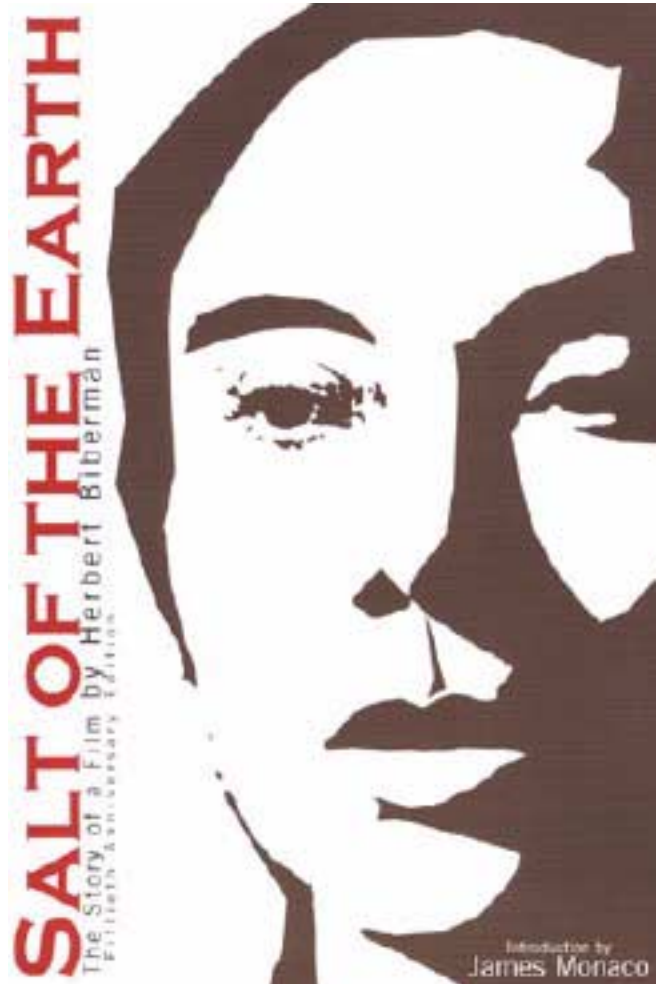

In 1952 three blacklisted Hollywood filmmakers set out to make a movie about the true story of a strike by Mexican-American zinc miners in New Mexico. One of the great union stories of all time, it was nevertheless smothered by corrupt Hollywood unions. Biberman and partners Paul Jarrico and Michael Wilson then struggled for more than 15 years to get their film seen. Years later, after two of the three partners had died, it would be one of the first films chosen to be listed in the **NATIONAL FILM REGISTRY**—films to be preserved for all time.
